Dear Parents,

I am writing to confirm that the lower floor of the Primary School will re-open from tomorrow, Monday 15th March 2021. The move to virtual learning was a precautionary measure, and after completing the compulsory 10 days we are looking forward to welcoming back all students in Nursery, FS2, Year 1, Year 2 and class 3F.

As per the usual arrangements, please notify the class teacher or form teacher if your child is absent along with the reasons for any absence.
