Olympic Village

When not competing or cheering on friends, your child will rest, recuperate and play at the Olympic Village located on campus. The Olympic Village will have an Esports Video Truck, Planet Smoothie cart, STEAM interactive booth, and live DJ. Lunch and snacks will be provided by our new caterer, FLIK Hospitality Group. Each day we will have a variety of options including American, Asian, Italian, and Latin style foods.

Accommodations Tuesday, December 3, 2019 - Saturday, December 7, 2019

Your child will stay at one of the following hotels below, both located only 15 minutes from Windermere Preparatory School. Hotel rooms will sleep two to three students, each with his or her own bed. Chaperones will stay separately. Windermere Preparatory School students will not stay at hotels.

THE COURTYARD MARRIOTT ORLANDO LAKE BUENA VISTA

The Courtyard Marriott Orlando Buena Vista features outdoor pools, free Wi-Fi, bistro, game room, fitness center and convenience store for grab and go snacks.

HYATT PLACE ORLANDO

The Hyatt Place Orlando is located across the street from the Courtyard Marriott Orlando Lake Buena Vista and features an outdoor pool, free Wi-Fi, fitness center, and convenience store for grab and go snacks.



Flights

Nord Anglia Education will book and manage all flights taking into account costs and timings.

It will be the responsibility of the parents to bring their child to and from their home airport. We require a parent to accompany their child when meeting the chaperone at the drop off point inside the airport. Parents also must be present to pick up their children.

Transportation in Florida

Nord Anglia Education will arrange all ground transportation, which includes travel between the hotels and Windermere Preparatory School and to all evening activities. Those schools arriving into Orlando International Airport (MCO) will be transported by coach/shuttle to the Courtyard Orlando Lake Buena Vista or Hyatt Place Orlando and returns.

For schools in Florida, we will arrange coach buses from your child's school to and from the hotel.

Coaches/Chaperones

Your child's safety is our highest priority. Throughout the Global Games, your child will be assigned a chaperone to ensure that your child is supervised. Chaperones are required to attend the entire week of the Global Games. Each chaperone will be assigned ten students to oversee during the entire week. Chaperones are appointed by the Athletic Director of each school. Only school staff may chaperone.

Itinerary

The Global Games, The Americas is an exciting 5-day program packed with sports competitions, activities and the chance to make new friends from Nord Anglia's schools across the region. The program is designed to enable your child to thrive in an atmosphere of ambition, sportsmanship and teamwork.

Read about the exciting activities we have lined up for your child in this year's itinerary.

DAY 1

Arrival and Opening Dinner at Pirates Adventure or Cirque Magique Shows – New Activity!

After registering and settling in to the hotel, your child will have a chance to relax by the pool or hang out at the hotel with friends. Lunch will be provided to the schools who arrive near lunchtime.

In the evening, we kick off the Global Games with an exciting, family-friendly dinner at Pirates Adventures and Cirque Magique Dinner Shows. Both venues are dinner theater experiences that take place either on a Spanish Galleon Ship or under the Big Top.

DAY 2

Global Games Opening Ceremonies and then off to Andretti Indoor Karting and Games

Your child will participate in the first day of competition and enjoy free time between events in the on-campus Olympic Village.

At the end of the day, your child will make a short stop at the hotel to clean up and then head to Andretti Karting and Games for dinner and to play video games, go-kart, bowl, laser tag and more! Nord Anglia Education has reserved the entire facility for our athletes.

DAY 3

The Global Games continues with Mickey's Very Merry Christmas!

Quarter and Semifinals competitions will be held throughout the day along with fun activities at the Olympic Village.

Dinner and evening activities will take place at Walt Disney World's Magic Kingdom. Your child will enjoy all the Mickey's Very Merry Christmas festivities including an amazing fireworks show above Cinderella's Castle, snow falling on Main Street with hot chocolate, cider and cookies, and the famous Once Upon a Christmas Parade.

DAY 4

The final day of the Global Games, Awards Ceremony, and Islands of Adventure!

The championship games are held in the morning and culminate in the closing awards ceremony which conclude by early afternoon, leaving your child plenty of time to visit Islands of Adventure theme park. Islands of Adventure features the amazing Harry Potter and the Forbidden Journey, The Incredible Hulk Coaster, and Jurassic Park River Adventure. Students and chaperones will be given a \$20 gift card to buy dinner at the park. Buses will transport students to the hotel at park closing time. Snacks will be provided upon arrival. Students from North Broward and Windermere schools will head home.

DAY 5

Departure

Students and chaperones will be transported from the hotel to the airport via coach bus. All departure times will be pre-arranged according to each school's flight time.

ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Please register your student between August 12 and September 25, 2019. Go to this link: www.nae.school/global-games
- Parents are required to register on their child's behalf. September 25th is a firm deadline.
- Payments can be made by Credit Card or via Student School Account (where tuition is paid).
- Full payment is due by Friday, November 1. No installment payments are allowed.
- <u>No Refund Policy</u>. No refunds will be given, regardless of your circumstance. If you have registered online and need to cancel, you will still be responsible in paying the full package fee.
- Purchasing Individual Insurance Coverage is Highly Recommended. Purchasing RegSaver insurance covers the entire cost of the Student Games Package Fee in the event of an emergency. The cost is only 6% of the student package.
