SCAD LANGUAGE STUDIO AN INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY

SCAD is a global university with locations on three continents and students from more than 100 countries. As a new international student, you can begin your SCAD journey through the intensive and engaging art- and design-focused English language programs offered by the SCAD Language Studio.

The SCAD Language Studio provides an authentic studio experience through comprehensive language studies, collaborative fieldwork and a blended learning approach to language acquisition specific to university life. Students are exposed to extended learning opportunities beyond the classroom, with options to observe for-credit classes, explore innovative digital learning environments and attend lectures or exhibitions.

The SCAD Language Studio offers English as a Second Language (ESL), the English Language Program (ELP) and the Cultural and Academic Preparation Program (CAPP).

ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE DESIGNED TO HELP YOU SUCCEED

The SCAD Language Studio provides English as a Second Language (ESL) instruction appropriate to varied student needs, levels and proficiencies to prepare students for degreegranting programs at SCAD. ESL students make connections with peers and professors, and use their language skills to succeed in their studies and to begin their academic and artistic journeys at SCAD with confidence and competence.

Through the SCAD Language Studio, you gain skills that will enable you to be successful at the university and professional level, including how to:

- Write academic papers and exams.
- Make formal presentations.
- Read university-level materials.
- Comprehend academic lectures.
- Speak fluently in both formal and informal settings.
- Understand U.S. culture.

After taking the English proficiency test, you will be placed in one of six levels based on ability. Students who place in Levels 1 through 4 take ESL classes only, while students in Levels 5 and 6 take a blend of ESL and studio classes. While in the ESL program, you will be immersed in the university's creative and inspiring environment, and attend university events, lectures and workshops and participate in organized activities. The SCAD Language Studio also offers the English Language Program (ELP), which provides instruction to international students interested in exclusively developing their English to further their career or personal goals. Through ELP, you can experience a global art and design university as you develop your language skills, prepare for TOEFL and IELTS and receive support from advisers for mapping out the rest of your journey at SCAD. After taking the English proficiency test, your ELP course of study will be curated to meet your language needs. Students who successfully complete the ELP and apply to SCAD will fulfill the language requirements up to Level V as they begin their programs of study.
