1. From Ms Sarah (Principal)

Teacher Recruitment

We started the teacher recruitment process for the next academic year in October. This process starts early to ensure that we are able to select the best teachers within an international market. The majority of international schools are also starting at this time of the year. If we leave recruitment until later in the year, most of the best teachers have already found their next position. Starting to search for teachers in October means that we also have to establish which of our teachers wish to stay or decide not to extend their contracts (we offer 2 years with 1 or 2 year extensions). This is a normal process for all international schools. This year we expect about 45 teachers to be leaving us (40 left 2 years ago). Teachers move on for a variety of reasons, personal and professional. In only 4 out of 45 of these cases, we as a school have decided not to renew the contract of the teacher. The school works very hard to develop and keep the best teachers but every year there will be a turnover of staff, as in any international school environment. Although we are sad to see good teachers move away, this is also an opportunity for us to bring in new talent and expertise that matches our ambitions for the future of the school. There are also exceptional cases at the end of Term 1 where 4 teachers are leaving, 3 are due to personal/family reasons and 1 is to explore a new professional opportunity with a school that starts its calendar year in January. It is not common for contracts to be broken or for teachers to leave mid-year. Penalties are in place to deter teachers from breaking contract. As a leadership team, we will ensure no child's learning is affected and do everything we can to ensure a smooth transition to the next teacher. In some cases, the teachers have been replaced with new external teachers, in other cases, classes have been assigned to our current experienced teachers. If you have a concern about a teacher leaving that you think will affect your child then please come and speak to the Leadership Team.
