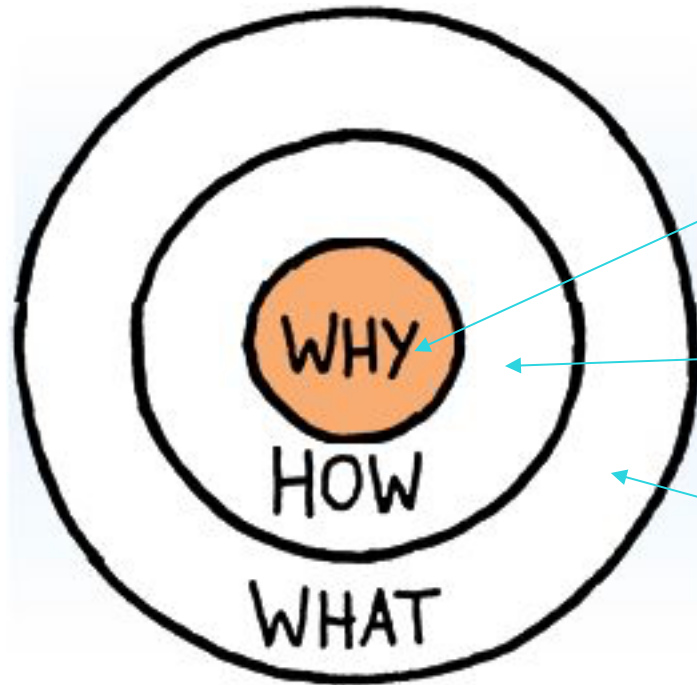

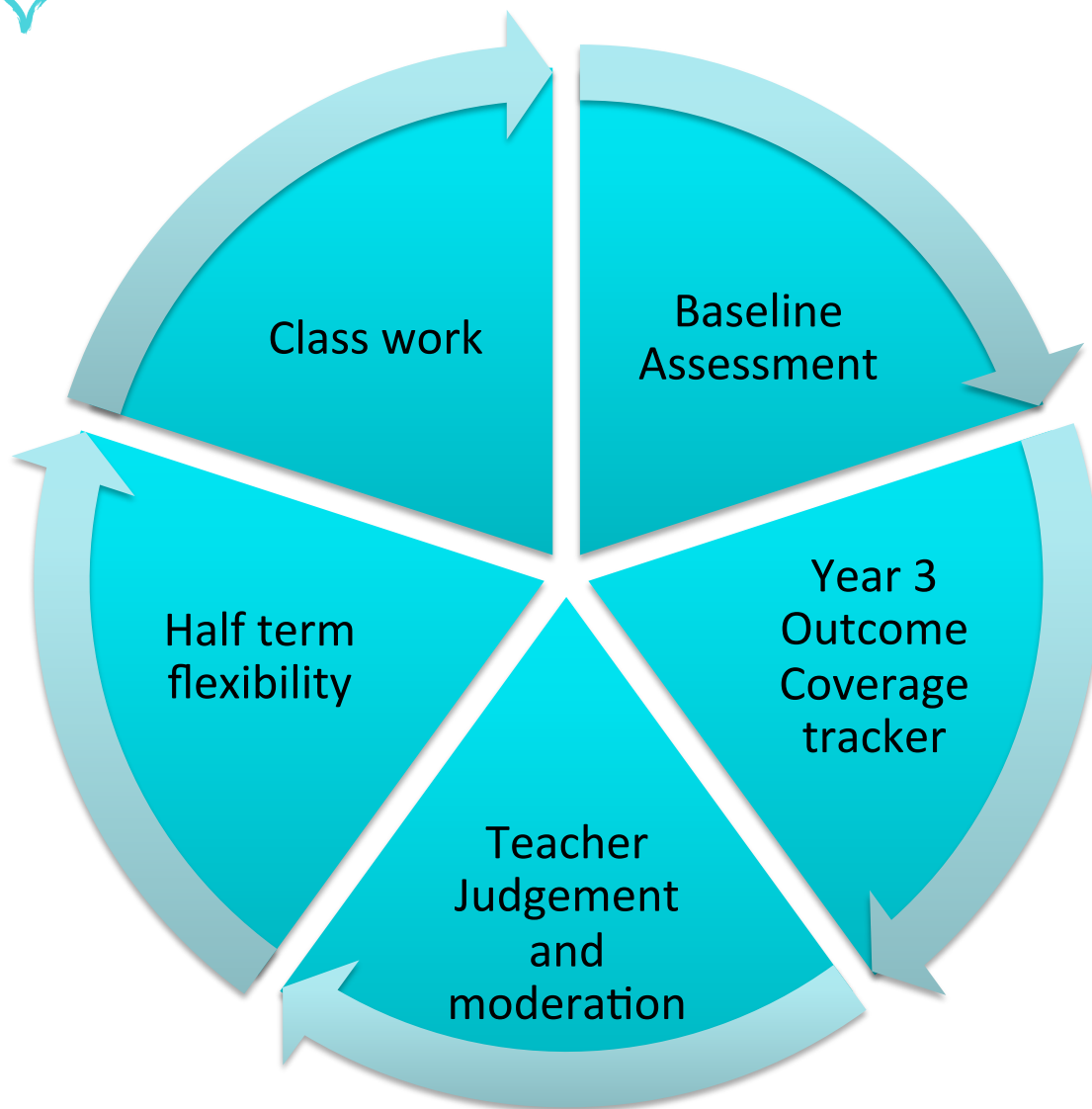


To ensure all pupils at DCIS have the best opportunity to make maximum progress in maths, regardless of maths ability.

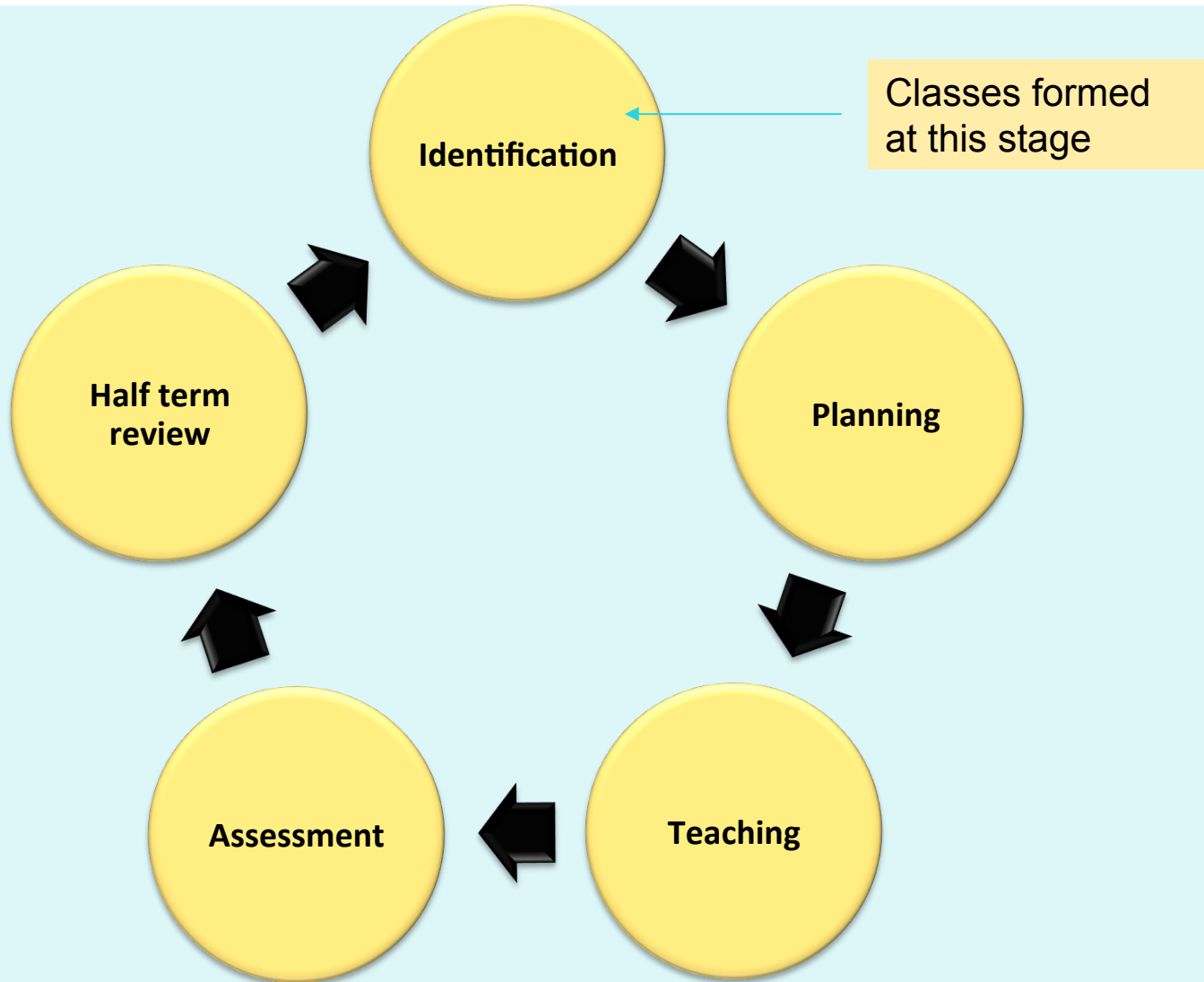

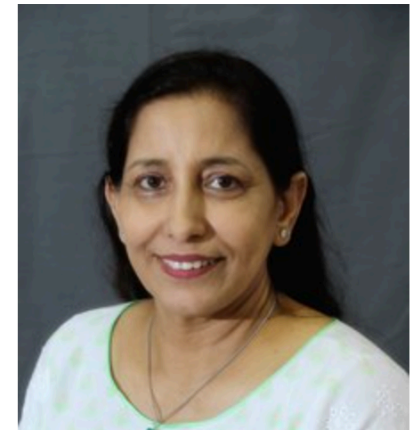
