Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) are an integral part of the education offered at BIS HCMC and provide our students with a broad range of learning opportunities which positively impact many facets of their development, including academic progress. The diverse co-curricular programme is designed to enhance the core curriculum and provide opportunities for students to broaden their interests and perspectives of the world as they develop a range of skills including social, emotional, leadership, independence, collaboration, moral reasoning, decision making, problem solving, and critical thinking.

Despite the need for students to remain at home for the start of Term 1, we are delighted to be able to continue the fabric of school life by including the CCA programme as part of the BIS Virtual Learning provision with a number of activities which have been modified to facilitate online engagement. We recognise that students engaging in Virtual Learning have less opportunity for making significant connections and this is even more vital during times of isolation and lockdown.

Some of these virtual clubs (VCCAs) will be 'live' with students able to interact with the teacher in charge as well as their fellow students and others will be pre-recorded allowing students to be more independently involved.

Although there are a reduced number of VCCAs to choose from each week at the BIS Secondary Campus, the range is still extensive with options available in each of the 5 categories of Creativity, Action, Service, Sustainability and Study Support. We would like to encourage each student to sign up for at least one club per week.

Guidelines for submission:

- The video recording should show the student playing or singing.
- The video should be of any piece you play well and should be between 30 seconds and 1 minute long there is no need to play the whole piece, just a small section.
- No piano accompaniment please we just want to hear your voice or instrument.
- You can give yourself a note on the piano to find your starting note when singing.

Activity dates for Term 1 2021-22:

All clubs will initially run for a 5 week block and following review, we hope to extend the programme for a further 5 week period.

Start: Monday 13th September 2021
End: Friday 15th October 2021

CCAs will run during lunchtimes, however, the majority are scheduled after timetabled lessons. The Virtual CCA Programme makes provision for two sessions each afternoon from 2:50pm – 3:50pm and from 3:55pm - 4:55pm. If activities take place beyond these times information is detailed in the booklet.

The aims of our Co-Curricular activities (CCAs) at BIS, HCMC are:

- To provide a <u>wide range</u> of enjoyable and challenging experiences above and beyond the timetabled curriculum
- To allow competitive teams, drama companies and music ensembles to reach high standards of team/group and personal performance
- To provide opportunities for students to aspire to elements of the school's mission statement
- To continue to develop our involvement in community work
- To offer a <u>balance of endeavour</u> which provides the framework for the IBDP CAS Programme

CAS at BIS

Creativity, Activity and Service are woven throughout the Co-Curricular Activities. Originating from the International Baccalaureate Programme they set out to challenge our students to show initiative and perseverance as well as to develop skills such as collaboration, problem solving and decision making. For a balanced experience, we encourage students to take part in at least one of each of the three areas below:

Creativity: The arts, music, languages and other experiences that involve creative thinking.

• **Activity:** Physical exertion contributing to a healthy lifestyle.

Service: Any collaborative and reciprocal community engagement in response to an

authentic need.

On-line CCA Selection – using SchoolsBuddy

Activities need to be selected using the online SchoolsBuddy system. Please see the next page for further instructions.

You will be able to see updates and changes to your approved activities through your on-line SchoolsBuddy homepage. Both the student and their parents will also receive notification when accepted for participation in a CCA.

For the majority of CCAs, the online system (SchoolsBuddy) will randomly allocate students to each CCA. As it is not a first come first served system, you may not always get your first choice activity.

Paid Activities

There are a number of paid activities that students can sign up for such as Yoga, K-Pop, Hip Hop, as well as kickboxing and even football. These are provided by external individuals and organisations with all information about them detailed in the online activities booklet. The external providers have collaborated with BIS and understand the importance of their role in supporting the wellbeing of our students by providing meaningful connections and support beyond the context of a virtual classroom. All costs have been limited to under VND 160,000 per session.

If a student has selected a paid activity, an email confirming their choice will be sent to both the student and their parents.

The payment deadline for all paid clubs is Monday 6th September 2021.

Due to the current situation in Ho Chi Minh City, payments for paid VCCA options that a student has been accepted into can only be made through online banking. If unable to fulfil these conditions, students should please not sign up for a paid VCCA as an option.

Payment amounts for those clubs which a student has been accepted into will be emailed to students and parents on Wednesday 1st September, with payment the payment deadline being the end of the banking day on Monday 6th September 2021. Please keep in mind that both Thursday and Friday are bank holidays; payment transfers should be made early in order to ensure that spaces are held.

All VCCAs will start on the week beginning the 13th of September. If payment has not been cleared by our accounts team by Thursday the 9th, a place will not be available.







Making After School Club Selections (CCAs)

1. Click the 'Activities & Clubs' tab, or click on an Available signups container.




2. Depending on the activities, clubs and care your school provides, you may see just one or multiple boxes similar to the one below. They should be clearly labelled so you can see what is available to you. Click the 'choose' button.



- 3. From there, the clubs that are available will be shown by day of the week.
- 4. Click the day of the week to expand the section.
- 5. Select your preferences for each club for the desired day of the week.

In the example below, Bobby Smith has selected Creative Coding Club on a Wednesday as their first choice, but, in case there are not enough spaces, Bobby has selected Music Technology Club as a second preference. Bobby is trying to ensure that they have a club on a Wednesday but show the school that they would prefer to do Creative Coding.


It is fine to leave some clubs without any preference selections, the tick will remain in the N/A box to show that you do not wish to select this club.






If you save for later, when you return to the Activities & Clubs tab, click the Review/Send button to complete your selections and send them to the school.






After clicking the link above, you will be directed to the login page. Do not add your email directly to this page, but instead, click on iSAMS (Parent) as seen to the left.


This will direct you to the iSAMS login page.



Unlike a game of make-believe, D&D gives structure to the stories, a way of determining the consequences of the adventure's action. Players roll dice to resolve whether their attacks hit or miss or whether their adventurers can scale a cliff, roll away from the strike of a magical lightning bolt, or pull off some other dangerous task. Anything is possible, but the dice make some outcomes more probable than others. In the Dungeons & Dragons game, each player creates an adventurer (also called a character) and teams up with other adventurers (played by friends).
