Curriculum Overview for Foundation Stage

By the end of the academic year our Fs pupils would be able to:

- . Introduce themselves to their classmates.
- . Talk about rules and outlines of the school day.
- . Identify the different family members.
- . Recognise 2D shapes (rectangle, square, circle, triangle).
- . Recognise numbers from 1-5 (Fs1), 1-10 (Fs2).
- . Introduce some colors.
- . Learn the days of the week.
- . Talk about the colors of the UAE flag, practice the national Anthem song and introduce the seven Emirates.
- . Introduce some fruits and vegetables.
- . Talk about the class objects.
- . Recognise some letters of the alphabet (shape and sound).
- . Assist our children (fs2) to trace from right to left.
- . Auditory sorts (usually accompanied by a picture) encourage the pupils to listen to the sounds at the beginning of words.

Number of lessons per timetable cycle: 2

Remark: We are learning the above topics through different ways:

- . Whole group or circle time, which is ideal for social and academic skills.
- . Small group for more focus.
- . Activities to develop fine motor control, and improve eye/hand coordination: modeling dough, coloring, dot-to-dot, tracing, and copying shapes.
- . A variety of preps to support role play
- . Listen to songs related to our topics.
