

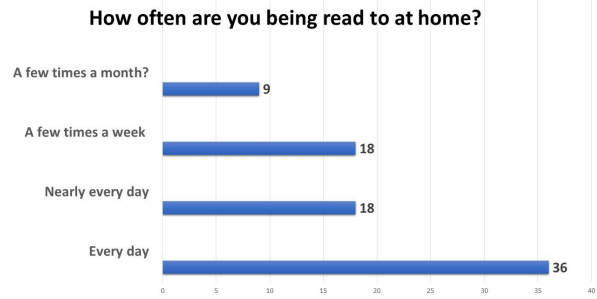
“The more that you read, the more things you will know. The more you learn, the more places you’ll go.”— Dr. Seuss

The lead up to Book Week sparked our curiosity. What do our students like to read? How often are they reading? When are they reading? Where are they reading? Do they even like reading?!

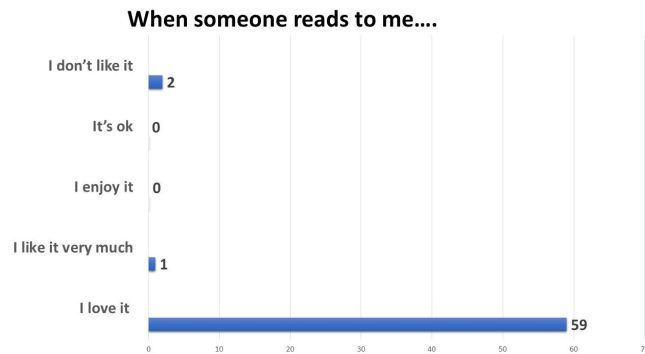
As a result, we created a child friendly Reading Survey. The children in Year 1-6 completed this Reading Survey in their classes. Here are some of the results:

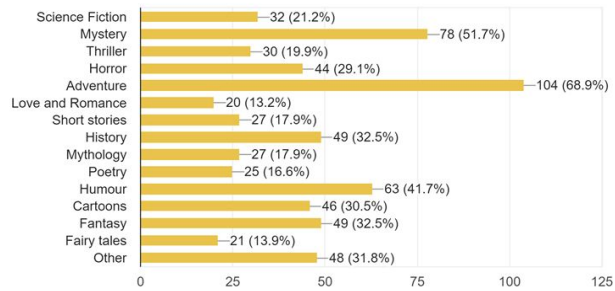

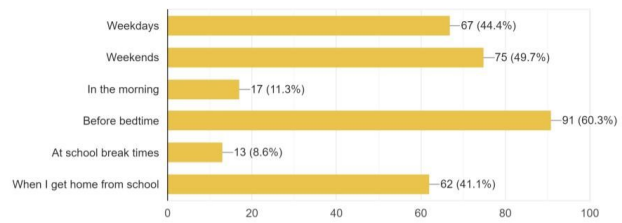
What is your favourite genre to read?

When do you read the most?

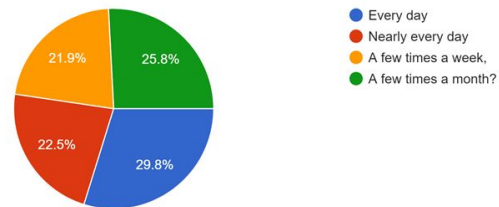
When do you read the most? (check all choices that apply to you.)

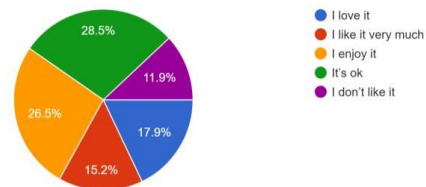
How often are you being read to at home? (choose from the dropdown)
