Beau Soleil's tradition of providing an exciting and extensive programme of school trips continues with an amazing selection of options for our students – in fact we have over 35 trips planned throughout the school year.

Our trips are very much an extension of school life providing relevant and challenging experiences for our students. The specific aims of these opportunities varies between, culture, adventure, service and academic enrichment.

Many of our trips are planned with specific groups in mind, others require a selection process particularly if it involves the fitness and determination to climb a high mountain or a specific skill or qualification (e.g. scuba diving). Some of the trips are also strongly associated with an academic subject or may be a requirement for a particular academic course.

A general rule with all trips is that students conduct in school has to be good – failure to complete academic requirements or discipline issues can result in students being turned down or removed from a trip list.

End of year class trips are compulsory for all and are included in the school fees. Each of the year end trip destinations is chosen carefully to ensure that different year groups take part in an amazing opportunity altogether. More details and destinations will be communicated later in the year.

ROUND SQUARE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE, INDORE



BATTLEFIELDS OF PICARDY

Our students will be able to walk through the trenches, visit museums and have a demonstration of the uniform and weapons used during the war. We will also enjoy free time in the beautiful city of Arras and some fun additional activities including bowling and a visit to an aquatic centre.

IB Theatre students



Students will be selected by the Beau Soleil Football coach after a term of training.










SERVICE TRIP BHUTAN

All students with open water diving qualifications




Let's go scuba diving in one of the most beautiful dive spots in the world!

We journey onward to the highest lake in the world to marvel at the vast blue azure waters of Lake Titicaca, birthplace of the Incas.

All students




Namibia is a stunning country with amazing wildlife viewing opportunities.

MOUNT GUALLATIRI CHILE

5 - 16 February 2020

Guallatiri is a volcano that is 6063m high and it is the highest peak Beau Soleil students have summited! In character it rises in isolation from a highland plain where its scree and rocky slopes create a fantastic and beautiful form. We are delighted to be attempting this climb and it will be a fantastic adventure.

The expedition will begin in Santiago with our

primary objective over the first few days to acclimatize. We will do this by climbing three summits before travelling to the Guallatiri Base Camp where we will make our summit attempt. The team will be required to take part in a vigorous training programme through January and February and any applications are subject to selection.









CHINA

After working hard we will then move on to the cultural and exploration phase of our journey. Visiting beaches with snorkeling on coral reefs,


visits to waterfalls and exploration of the UNESCO World Heritage city of Santo Domingo.

DUBLIN


6 - 8 March 2020






BRIANÇON 5 - 9 mai 2020








MOSCOW








This trip will consist of experiencing the city attractions and the cultural history of the city and Russia. We will also visit entertainment complexes, an aqua park, and shopping areas.
