





THE GLOBAL CAMPUS EXPEDITION

TANZANIA 22nd February – 1st March 2017



Champittet students (Grades 11 - 12 - 13) are being given an amazing opportunity to participate in a Global Campus activity in Tanzania. They will have the chance to discover a new culture, meet new people, explore new places and make a difference to the lives of others. All while having lots of fun and gaining valuable experiences that will have a positive impact on their futures.

THE PURPOSE OF THE EXPEDITION

Nord Anglia Education's Global Campus provides a contemporary and distinctive learning environment for the students in our family of schools. Global Campus's activity is an opportunity for students to come together and explore global issues through a variety of carefully planned experiences. Throughout the year, close to 1'000 students from Asia, the Americas, the Middle-East and Europe meet at the Tanzania expeditionary base. For Champittet students, it is a unique opportunity to make a great experience and connect with students from all over the world.

ACTIVITIES

All students will have the opportunity to take part in a variety of activities, both in the local community and in the camp. Activities will be focused on learning about the issues facing the area, and on making a practical difference to the lives of others. They will learn about broader issues such as the local environment and the history of slavery where relevant.

Once students have been selected for the expedition, there will be a series of preparatory activities. When they return students will be required to share their experiences with their school and the Global Campus.

SELECTION OF STUDENTS

Students will be selected based on their motivation to attend the expedition and their academic record. Students in their final year of studies will only be considered if their grades are deemed favourable.

COSTS

Students will have to pay for the flights, insurance, vaccinations (including Antimalarial Tablets), visa. We do not have details yet but the cost will be approximately **CHF 1500.-/2000.**-.

Students will also need to fundraise 350 euros for use in local service projects (they will be helped by their teachers).

Once students have been selected for the expedition, we will organise a meeting with students and their parents to explain all the details about the expedition.
