



TEAM BISB team selection process

How can I be selected?

Although all our TEAM BISB training sessions are fully inclusive, and we would like to give the opportunity to all of our team members to participate in a variety of tournaments, it is impossible to provide enough games for everyone due to time restrictions and the limited number of participants in some events. Therefore, we have to apply many selection criteria for these events, which are shared with the students at the beginning of each sporting season by their coaches. We kindly ask parents to help us in explaining to their children that they need to prepare for the fact they may not be selected, which we understand can be very disappointing.

- If a student wishes to represent TEAM BISB at the Budapest Cup, the Nord Anglia Education (NAE) or the Danube Valley Athletic Conference (DVAC) events or inter-school fixtures, the following criteria will be applied:
 - Regular participation in P.E. lessons (if appropriate) and training sessions is a requirement
 - Total commitment as a player;
 - The ability to collaborate with other teammates and the coach/es;
 - Confidence in dealing with challenges and new situations;
 - Perseverance to carry on working hard and face difficulties when there is little prospect of success;
 - Risk taking and trying out new ideas and tackling challenges;
 - Level of physical fitness (in the relevant sport);
 - Skill level (in the relevant sport);
 - General school effort;
 - Sportsmanship, fair play.



Restrictions in number and combinations, and the student's age could also be a deciding factor. Older year groups within each Key Stage have priority in the selection process.

Reserves will be selected for each team and each tournament, in case injury or other unforeseeable circumstances hinder a team member from participating.

Coaches will announce their team/s 1-6 weeks prior to the event. Local fixtures require a shorter time, while in the case of residential trips that involve more organisation (e.g. flight, hotel, insurance, etc.) a longer time frame is applied.

Satisfactory effort and academic performance are the minimum requirements for selection within TEAM BISB. Students, who do not meet these expectations across the school, risk being withdrawn from squads.
