The Divisional Admissions Committee will begin reviewing student files that are complete in December and continue until spaces for the 2018 – 2019 school year are filled. Most new student decisions will not be released until the re-enrollment deadline has passed. For grade levels where an increase in student spaces exist, Early Decision offers will be made based upon available space.

Following review by the Admissions Committee, students may be asked to come in for additional testing, interview or visitation. This request provides us with further information necessary prior to making a committee decision.
