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Classes & Descriptions

Chess

The classic game of chess stimulates a child's problem-solving aptitude, focus, and critical thinking abilities, along with providing lifelong lessons in patience, foresight, and evaluation. Chess is also proven to help children build mathematic and science skills and self-discipline. Our chess team is taught by master-level coaches and has a long history of state and national championships for both the team as a whole and individual member.

*Cook, Learn, Grow—Kids Can Cook!

Junior Chef - The kitchen is the hub of nourishment, learning, and growing individually and as a community. Our Junior Chefs program offers students an experience in culinary arts through age-appropriate techniques, creativity enriched with literacy and STEM-based activities and a community food project. Sample themes: Science and Math in the Kitchen, STEM Enrichment, Food as Fuel - food groups expanded, and Community Food Project - helping others. **There will be an additional \$50 supply fee added to this class.*

*Dance

This program is designed to teach kids the basic fundamentals of dance in a variety of dance techniques and styles. In the Fall semester, we will cover ballet and hip-hop. The students can start to develop as performers, feel comfortable letting go, and expressing themselves through the popular art form of dance; all while learning things about themselves and different styles. This class will be so much fun for everyone involved! The attire will be black leotard and pink tights with ballet shoes. Students are not required to dress out for class, but will need these things for the fall recital. **There will be an additional \$40 Costume fee added to this class.*

Global Academic Coaching

This enjoyable program takes your child on a journey of discovering their gifts, talents and strengths; equipping them with invaluable skills that will build their confidence. These self-management skills include: time management; overcoming procrastination; organization; good study habits; note-taking skills and disciplining their mind. Classes & Descriptions

Graphic Design

Messy Art Room

Quiz Bowl

Quiz Bowl is an academic competition in which two teams of four players each face off to answer questions on a wide variety of academic subject areas. The questions are asked and answered orally (not written) on subjects ranging from science to fine arts to geography to literature to current events – and everything in between. Students compete with each other to answer questions quickly and accurately using an electronic buzzer lock-out system, similar to the ones used on TV game shows such as “Jeopardy.” Numerous competitions are held each year on weekends that attract teams from across the state and country.

Quiz Bowl students are typically students who are intellectually curious about the world around them, want to challenge themselves and learn new things, and are stimulated by competition. They develop leadership, communication skills, and the ability to think critically on the fly.

Rugby

As one of the fastest growing youth sports in America, rugby has captured the imagination across the country with its combination of athleticism, excitement, and team camaraderie. Now here is your opportunity to try flag rugby on your campus with Rookie Rugby!
