

## Policies and Procedures

1. Aambassador Transportation Services will disinfect buses at their business site location. When buses are left on campus there will be a designated person for this job. Those vehicles that daily return to the Aambassador location will also be similarly disinfected.
2. Every morning the temperature of each child will be taken before they enter the bus. If a child has a temperature of 99.5 or above, he/she will not be allowed to enter the bus. Parents, you will need to wait at the bus stop until your child has boarded the vehicle in case they need to return home. Note: There is no need to take temperatures before boarding in the afternoon since the students have been monitored all day in our buildings.
3. Bus driver health statement from Aambassador: “All of our employees are asked and encouraged to report any illness or symptoms at once. They will be tested for COVID 19 and, based on the results, we will ask them to seek medical help and self-quarantine until they are tested negative and released by their doctor to come back to work.”
4. Hand sanitizer will be available to all students at the point of bus entry.
5. Every bus rider (including the driver) must wear a mask for the entire ride.
6. We are limiting the seating capacity on all our vehicles. Our 46 passenger buses will now only seat 37 riders. Siblings will be allowed to sit together in order for the maximum number of students to social distance.
7. Once seated, either in the morning or in the afternoon, students will not be allowed off the bus. One of our goals is to minimize the interaction between students both on and off the bus. Walking on and off the bus repeatedly, passing by other students, increases the opportunity for transmission of infection.  
Once seated--stay seated for the entire bus ride.
