Today, The Village School inhabits over 28 acres in a residential area of West Houston. The campus consists of more than 337,000 square feet of facilities. In addition, the school recently completed an extensive campus expansion with a new state-of-the-art gymnasium and competitive swim center. Our community of students from over 60 nations shares a commitment to uncommonly high levels of achievement. Our dedicated and caring faculty and staff continue to prepare students for future success at the most prestigious colleges and universities throughout the world.
