

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **<u>next week</u>**.

In *Literacy*, students will be creating a poster of the features of formal letters. They will then identify the word features of formal letters, searching for adjectives, adverbs and high level conjunctions. Students will make notes to plan their ideas for apology letters. In Big Writing students will be writing a letter of apology to Lady Isabella regarding Goldilocks' unacceptable behaviour at the party.

In *Numeracy*, students will be practising their knowledge of place value and will be learning how to subtract using the column method. They will solve word problems which involve the four operations. In the final lesson, children will be learning about different measures (kg and g).

In *Science*, students will be working with their partner to show their investigation at the Primary Science Fair. During any additional time, we will continue work on the senses. Hopefully our chicks will be hatching too!

In *IPC*, students will be continuing to use their scripts and offer tours of the school, where they will be identifying the school's geographical features. Then the students will look at different types of art and giving their own opinion as to why art work can be regarded as treasure. Then the students will be looking at broken pieces of artefacts and they will use their archaeological knowledge to identify what they think the artefact would have been before it broke.

In *Art / Technology*, students will be using water colour paints and pens to create a 'through the keyhole' scene. Linking to science work on the senses, they will need to imagine what their eye might see through a magic keyhole.

In *ICT*, students will be complete their scratch projects on 'Rock band'.

For *PSHE*, students will be reflecting on their achievements and favourite moments of this year. They will also identify any areas for development.

Notice & Reminders:

- As the weather starts to warm, please ensure **water bottles** and **hats** are making their way to school. These should be clearly labelled with **names** and **classes**.
- Reading records should be signed each and every time you read with your children to keep a log of how often they read. They can be reading any material; the colour banded books that are sent home, library books, books at home, online books, newspapers (for children), magazines,

comic books, etc.

- Please remember that learning starts at 7:10. Reading and phonics starts the day so any late arrivals miss valuable learning time. Please ensure students arrive promptly at **7:00**.
