- o The first task needs to be completed before the Christmas holidays!.



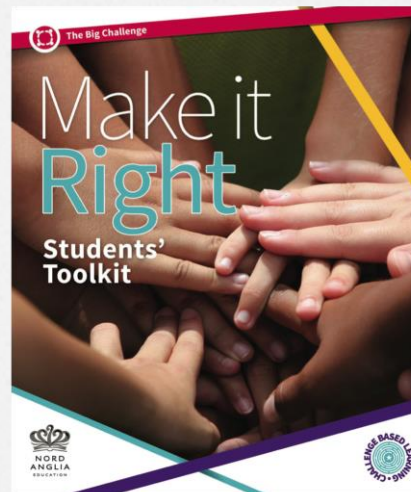
