

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, we will be embarking on a new in a new adventure in Literacy. Students will be time travelling back to the Middle Ages in England to complete various missions in our new Big Write Adventures.

In **Numeracy**, we will be answering word problems for the four operations using the RUCSAC method to answer the questions. We will be revising our knowledge of multiplying fractions and converting the improper fractions into mixed numbers. We will also be revising our knowledge of multiplying large numbers using a written method.

In **Science**, we will be understanding that insects pollinate some flowers and looking at how they do that. We will also be recognising that flowering plants have a life cycle including pollination, fertilisation, seed production, seed dispersal and germination.

In **IPC**, we will be recording positive and negatives of tourism and students will present their findings in a presentation. We will also be looking at extreme weather conditions and will plan to write an article about it.

In **ICT**, students will be starting their new topic 'We are architectures'. We will be exploring virtual art galleries from all over the world. Students will be looking at the interior and the artwork displayed and why certain artwork is grouped in a certain way.

In **PSHE**, we will be looking at how we can put in basic emergency aid procedures (including the recovery position) and know how to get help in emergency situations. We will also be looking at how we can keep ourselves calm in those situations.

For **Spellings**, students will receive their spelling lists every week and will be tested on the list on the same day, the following week. Please see student's timetables to see when they have spellings. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
