#### Literacy

Literacy we are starting a new unit on information texts. Linking our learning with our Water topic, we will looking at the water crisis that China is currently facing and we will be working towards creating a leaflet outlining why and how we can save water. Our focus this week will be on the structure and language features of an information text, planning methods and writing an effective introduction. Our SPAG focus will be formal and informal language, inverted commas and 'c' makes 's'.

#### Maths

Next week in Maths we will be examining the relationships between fractions, decimals and percentages. Students will calculate percentages of amounts, and explore percentages in ratios.

# Themed Learning

"Water for everyone"

We are investigating the big question "Is water the most valuable resource on the planet?"

This week in Themed Learning we will be developing our understanding of waterassociated disasters, both natural and man-made. Our journey will begin here in China and take us through many different countries, learning about how disasters are caused and how they are managed. Using our geographical mapping skills we will discover which areas most frequently experience similar problems and how the lives of the inhabitants of these regions are affected.
