Literacy

This week, we will be starting a new unit of work on poetry. Children will read a range of poems and look at how they are structured differently to stories and non-fiction texts. They will focus on the concept of rhyme, learning about similar sounds and their different spellings. Linking in with our Themed Learning topic **All Dressed Up**, we will be reading poems about clothes and dressing up, as well poems from other sources.

Maths

In Maths, we will be learning all about our 2, 5 and 10 times table. We will be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and learning how to multiply numbers together. Throughout the week, we will carry out a range of paired, group, practical and computer-based tasks in order to help us learn our times tables.

Themed Learning - All Dressed Up

This week, children will start to focus on the scientific element included in this unit of work, looking at different materials up close. We will be describing and categorizing materials using scientific vocabulary. As a class, we will create class Wordles to describe each material. We will begin to investigate the concept of waterproof materials and design a raincoat for Barnaby Bear to wear in wet weather.

This week in Computing Science, the children will continue to use cameras to take photographs to finish making a photo diary of the design process for their toy or doll.

PSHCE- Listening Skills

This week, we will continue to work on our listening skills. Through playing games and working on discussion tasks, we will be encouraging the children to focus heavily on their listening and explore ways in which they might manage distractions around them.


