SHANGHAI DUTCH SCHOOL (SDS)

SDS is officially recognised and financially supported by the Dutch government. Students are assessed through a programme related test every three weeks.

Students follow the English National Curriculum with enhanced Global Languages provision including German, Spanish, French, Chinese and Korean. At age 16 they sit examinations in up to 10 subjects, earning IGCSE qualifications. Senior students aged 17 and 18 go on to study for the International Baccalaureate Diploma.



Our Students Shine

Taking IGCSE examinations followed by the IB Diploma is a highly regarded route to universities and colleges around the world. The IB Diploma is recognised as the most prestigious worldwide pre-university award.

Our students not only succeed while they are at school, but the courses they study lay the foundations for future success at the next level too.

Year on year our students continue to achieve outstanding results. In 2016, 53% of all the grades from our IGCSE cohort were A or A*, more than double the world average of 21%. Finally, 25% of the same year's IB cohort achieved over 40 points, a globally acknowledged mark of true excellence, and 5 times the global figure of 5%.

The key to success in our school is a highly qualified, experienced and inspirational team of teachers committed to helping the students in our care be the best they can be. We remain committed to ongoing improvement.


NORD ANGLIA UNIVERSITY






