As soon as you have submitted your registration, we will start the process of allocating a teacher and arranging a timetable for your child. You will be notified about the amount of the fees and how to pay (bank transfer or QR code). Outstanding or un-used fees for previous lessons will be debited / credited for this term.

Registrations are now open until Wednesday 7th October at Midnight.

Lessons will be scheduled on a rotational basis. You child's timetable will be emailed to you by the instrumental instructor. The number of lessons during term 1 will be 7. In the second and third term we will revert to ten lessons a term. Fees will be charged at 200RMB for a thirty-minute lessons or 400RMB for an hour.



If you know in advance that your child is going to be absent, please inform me as well as the instrumental teacher the day before a scheduled lesson or earlier. If your child is absent from school due to illness, please notify me so that I can inform the relevant teachers. Lessons missed due to compulsory school activities and teacher absence will be made up by the teacher concerned.

We reserve the right to charge for lessons which have been missed where this has not been communicated in a reasonable manner.

Equipment

Students must bring their Music Learning Journals and music scores to all lessons together with their instruments. The Music Learning Journals will be used for communication between parents and peripatetic teachers.

Instruments

This year, the school has a range of Brass, Woodwind, and String instruments that students can use free of charge. Instruments will be issued on a first-come first-served basis and can be used for up to two full terms. Thereafter, parents and pupils will be requested to acquire their own instrument. Pianos and drum kits are not available.

General

All lessons take place in the B-block, on the third floor, except for percussion which will take place in Performing Arts Centre. The new allocated rooms offer a bigger space and appropriate social distancing measures will be implemented for instrumental lessons. Students are expected to leave their regular lessons five minutes before their scheduled time so that they can receive their full lesson allocation.

To make adequate progress, it is strongly recommended that students practise their instrument for a minimum of twenty minutes per day.

Parents are encouraged to organise suitable practice times as part of their child's regular homework routine.

All music students will be issued with a Music Learning Journal at the start of the term. Parents are requested to monitor and sign every week.
