**RE: YEAR 6 VISIT TO THE SHANGHAI JEWISH MUSEUM**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Year 6 will be going on an exciting educational visit to the Shanghai Jewish Museum. We will be investigating the exhibitions on offer in the museum, watching a short film and making our own documentaries on our iPads. We will also be embarking on a walking tour of the former Jewish Quarter of Shanghai and seeing how the landscape has changed since the end of World War 2. This visit is connected with our Themed Learning topic of World War 2 and will be a great opportunity for children to further develop their knowledge of the subject and its relevance to Shanghai.

This visit will take place on Thursday 29 October.

We will be leaving school at approximately 9.00am and returning to school in the afternoon in time for the usual end of day arrangements. We will travel by private school bus and ensure that children are wearing seat belts.

Students who normally have school lunch will be provided with a packed lunch on the day. All other students will need to provide their own lunch. You may pack an additional drink and small healthy (nut-free) snack should you wish to.

Students will be required to wear uniform as normal on the day, but should wear comfortable walking shoes and a jacket.

We would like three parent volunteers from each class to support us on this day. Please let us know if you would like to volunteer.
