Starters: Spelling



Access Spelling City or use your spelling words to write your spellings using something at home like play-doh, lego or sticks.

Draw pictures of your spelling words and write a sentence using it underneath.

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Write out the definitions of your spelling words using a dictionary.

Eg. A **<u>badge</u>** is something you wear on your clothes.

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Try and write a rhyming song using your spelling words that rhyme.

E.g. The budgie is judging, The giraffe was budging.

Main Course – you MUST do these every week:

- Reading 3 times a week <u>and</u> reading record signed
- Spellings
- Mathletics
- Reading Eggs
- Spelling City activities

Everyone **must** finish the main course every week. Work must be completed by Tuesday.

- Dessert projects are optional. If you have completed it, you will be asked to present your work to your teachers and peers.
- If you are feeling <u>extra</u> hungry, you can order from the starters. Each dish has a difficulty rating. The more chilies, the more challenging the task!
