The week ahead in Year 1 (2018)



Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next** week.

In *Numeracy*, the children will be using prior knowledge of place value to work out the value of different numbers. They will confidently be able to split up 2 digit numbers in to 10s and 1s. They will also be ordering numbers from the smallest to the biggest.

In *Literacy*, the children will be learning about signs, symbols and lists. They will be identifying different signs and symbols around the school and understand what they represent. They will also be learning about adding commas into a list.

In *Science*, this week the children will be continuing their exploration of forces. The children will be looking at a variety of different toys to see how they move and will classify them with a push or a pull movement. The children will also be walking around the school identifying different push and pull movements. For this week please can you send your child into class with a toy that they can share with the class.

In *PSHE*, the children will be exploring road safety. They will be designing their own road safety poster and will discuss the importance of crossing a road safely.

In *IPC*, the children will make their own mode of transport from recyclable materials. The children will learn about transport found on land and learn about the different objects found on the road, for example, road crossing, traffic lights.

In *Art*, the children will be using water colours to create a sunset desert scene. The children will use big brush strokes to merge red, yellow and orange together.
