#### Messages

- **Nuts** Please be reminded that we are a NUT FREE school. We have several children at each phase of the school with severe nut allergies (life threatening) that can be triggered just by coming into contact with nuts or nut traces in foods. Can we please ask you to be very vigilant in ensuring that all foods that come into school, taken onto school buses, taken to school trips or sporting fixtures, are completely nut free. We thanks you for your support to ensure that all our students can be happy and healthy at school.

### Literacy

In Literacy we will start our new unit of work on stories from other cultures. We will be focussing on developing the children's understanding of how to write a setting. They will call upon their knowledge of adjectives and appropriate nouns that they learned in

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their previous unit on poetry. We will also provide children with the opportunity to develop their use of grammar by learning about sentence structure, clause and openers.

#### Maths

The focus this week will be on multiplication and division. Children will be given opportunities to practise formal methods of multiplication with increasingly larger numbers. They will practise using mental calculations to become more efficient when working in unfamiliar situations. They will connect multiplication and division using word problems and investigations. The children will also work with ratio patterns, recognising as one number in a situation increases so does the other.

#### Themed Learning

#### **Active Planet**

The children will be focussing on History this week. They will research volcanic eruptions and then use primary evidence sources such as old newsreels, newspapers and paintings to stimulate a discussion on how different forms of evidence offer an historian a different perception of an historical event. At the end of the week the children will use their research to create their own piece of evidence; they can choose to produce a newspaper article, a radio broadcast, a short documentary style piece or a painting.

#### PSHCE

The children will be setting goals for the new term.

#### Vocabulary

Literacy – metaphor, simile, mood, atmosphere, Maths – multiplication, division, sharing, groups, array, two step-problems Humanities – evidence, source, primary secondary, opinion, facts, judgment

#### Dutch
