This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, we are learning to punctuate direct speech correctly, ensuring we put a punctuation mark before the inverted commas when we are including direct speech in the middle or the end of a sentence.

In **Numeracy**, we will be beginning our preparation for the upcoming Cambridge examinations by going over past papers from previous years. We will also be focusing on equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.

In **Science**, we will be beginning our Cambridge revision, looking at past papers and effective strategies to answer the questions.

In **IPC**, we will be completing our Futuristic art from last week, and will begin looking at Dadaistic art pieces by various artists.
