Consolidation

Over the final few weeks children will sit a maths PUMA test. This will give us an idea of any areas of learning children will need to cover again before they move up to Year 3. We will use this time to consolidate all of Year 2's learning.

Learning is opened through an entry point to engage pupils and assess their current understanding.

This term's topic is 'Green Fingers'. For our Entry Point the children are going to become gardeners and artists!

We have the amazing Craft Box coming in to lead a session with the children. During the morning, we will complete a range of fun and engaging activities around our new topic.



At the end of each unit, outcomes are celebrated an exit point

We will have been busy planting, growing and making so at the end of this unit we will be opening our own garden centre. Parents will be invited to come in and purchase items children have made. All money raised will be donated to charity.

Speaking, Listening & Drama Opportunities

Children will learn and perform their text maps through Talk for Writing in Literacy. The children will:

-Speak audibly and fluently with an increasing command of Standard English and participate in discussions, presentations, performances, role play and improvisations.

Science

This term, our Science will be mostly linked to our topic 'Green Fingers'.

In Science the children will:

- Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.
- Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Computing

Students will continue to develop their Computing skills by:

- Logging on to the network by themselves.
- Working collaboratively to build structures in Minecraft Education.
- Using block coding to program their agents in Minecraft Education.
- Reviewing their work in Minecraft Education and using reasoning to explain why they used specific materials.

The children will:
