# ORIENTATION DAYS THURSDAY 21 & FRIDAY 22 AUGUST

Orientation days are an opportunity for new parents and students to meet their new class teachers, to look around the school, to ask any questions, arrange bus routes, sort out uniform, meet other people – students, parents and staff – and generally get prepared for the start of term on Monday 25 August.

Please note that our staff tend to be very busy on these days, planning, preparing and setting up students' learning environments. Please help us by coming only at your allocated time as shown in the enclosed programme.

If you cannot make the allocated times, please let us know and we will try our very best to make other arrangements to see you and make sure that you are ready to start. We are delighted to talk to as many people as possible – that is our aim, but if you need a longer discussion about something specific, it is probably best to make a separate appointment, so we can make sure we have time to talk with you properly.

Students do not need to wear uniform for the orientation days – any sensible clothes are fine.

#### SCHOOL BUSES

If you would like to reserve a seat for your son or daughter on one of our school buses, please email us at schoolbus@bisspuxi.com or contact 5226 3211 ext. 1613, as early as possible. We will need to know your local contact details in Shanghai as soon as you know them (such as detailed address, home number and local mobile etc.) Please kindly send the above information by Friday 15 August 2014, if possible, as this will allow us to have timings for buses worked out for the first day of the new term. Our school bus monitor will phone you to discuss pick up and drop off points before the start of term.

#### **LUNCH CARDS**

School lunch cards can be purchased in our dining hall on the orientation days. Pupils are allocated a smart card and parents are asked to credit the card at the start of the term; a minimum start up balance of 500RMB is required. This can be topped up during the school term. Please be aware that our catering company cannot accept credit or debit cards. Payment can be made by cash (RMB)

or by bank transfer (details of bank account can be provided at orientation day).

#### **CONTACT DETAILS**

A great deal of the school and home communication is via email, although we do also phone at times, so it is very important that we have up-to-date email and phone information. We will ask you to complete a contact sheet when you come to the orientation day to help us with this.
