Our *Conductor* – Oliver Hagen from The Juilliard School

Conductor and pianist Oliver Hagen was born in New York City. He can be heard as a pianist on the 2017 Grammy-winning album of Steve Reich's music by Third Coast Percussion (Cedille Records). He recently toured with the percussion ensemble to Italy, performing at the MiTo Festival in Milan and Turin.

He toured with the percussion ensemble to Italy in 2016, performing at the MiTo Festival in Milan and Turin.

Hagen has conducted and taught at New York City conservatories for the last few years. Currently Hagen is on conducting and chamber music faculty at the Juilliard Pre-College Division and Music Advancement Program. Recently he has served as Preparatory Conductor for orchestras and ensembles at Manhattan School of Music's college division (MSM). Last October, Hagen conducted in concert with Tactus, the contemporary music ensemble at MSM. In the Fall of 2016, Hagen served as Guest Conductor for the Mannes Prepartory Division Philharmonic.

Between 2010 and 2012, Hagen was the Assistant Conductor of the Ensemble Intercontemporain in Paris. While there, he worked with Pierre Boulez, Susanna Mälkki, and Matthias Pintscher, among others. While with the ensemble, Hagen served as an Assistant Conductor at the Paris Opéra Comique and the Lucerne Festival Academy. Since 2012, Hagen has appeared with ensembles and orchestras such as the musicians of the Orchestre National de Lyon, American Composers' Orchestra, the New York New Music Ensemble, Ensemble LPR (le Poisson Rouge), East Coast Contemporary Ensemble, Ensemble mise-en, Firebird Ensemble, Ensemble soundinitiative, and the Orchestra of the League of Composers.

As one of the pianists in Ensemble Signal since 2008, Hagen has recorded music by Steve Reich (for Harmonia Mundi), Helmut Lachenmann (for Mode records), and David Lang, Michael Gordon, and Julia Wolfe (for Canteloupe). Hagen has worked directly with the above composers, as well as Charles Wuorinen, John Zorn, Unsuk Chin, Oliver Knussen, Roger Reynolds, and Kaija Saariaho. Having had a strong association with the Lucerne Festival Academy, Hagen took part in the 2009 performance of Pierre Boulez's Répons at the Lucerne KKL, as one of the solo pianists, with the composer at the podium. This will always be one of his most-cherished memories.

As one of the pianists in Ensemble Signal since 2008, Hagen has recorded music by Steve Reich (for Harmonia Mundi), Helmut Lachenmann (for Mode records), and David Lang, Michael Gordon, and Julia Wolfe (for Canteloupe).

Hagen completed his Doctor of Musical Arts degree at the Eastman School of Music, where he studied with Brad Lubman for many years. Hagen earned master's and bachelor's degrees at Eastman as well. His bachelor's degree is in clarinet and composition.
