Messages

All students will have the opportunity to participate in a minimum of 2 events. There is also an option to take part in a fun tug-of-war and House Team skipping. Years 5 and 6 students have been using curricular PE lessons to practise their events.

Certain events (track, high jump, skipping and tug of war) will be timetabled events. The remaining events of; long, triple, or three springs jump; quoit throw; shot putt and basketball push are non-timetabled events. This means that competitors can freely move around these events and perform when they have the chance and there is an opening at the events station.

Our learning this week will be based on one of ten pieces of music. Ten Pieces is a new initiative to take classical music into primary schools and inspire a generation of children to get creative. The 10 pieces have been selected with the intention of exposing younger children to the exciting world of classical music in an engaging, innovative manner. In Year 5 we will be focusing on Mars from Gustav Holst's The Planets. Students will be responding to the music verbally during class discussions, through their written work during Literacy lessons, and artistically during their Themed Learning sessions.

Literacy


In Literacy this week, we will be working on poetry. Students will be responding to a variety of different poems all based on the theme of space before writing their own. We will listen to a powerful piece of music and respond to this through generating our ideas on the theme of space. We will then be able to embed these creative ideas into the structure of some pieces of modern poetry so that the students can create a poem both original and challenging. Spellings will focus on words endings with the suffixes —tion, —sion, —sion, —cian. Our grammar focus will be on sentence structure and how to avoid using double negatives.

Maths

In Maths this week, we will be investigating size, ratio and proportion. Students will use their knowledge of the solar system to create scale diagrams of the planets, investigating both size of planet and distance from the sun. Students will have an opportunity to revise times tables knowledge throughout these activities while using them in a practical manner.

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Themed Learning

'Space'

During music week, we will be listening to music that inspired artists and art work in the past. Using Holst's The Planets – Mars, we will create mood boards, sketch our ideas inspired by the music and peer review each other's work.

PSHCE

In PSHCE this term we will be looking at teamwork and collaborative working. We will focus further on fostering new relationships, creating rules and expectations for the group and how to work together successfully.
