

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, students will be starting their new topic called, 'A Giant Birthday'. Students will be distinguishing between formal and informal language, making notes from information given to us and then using these notes to create personalised invitations for all of the guests from Cloudland.

In **Numeracy**, students will be practising their 3, 4 and 8 times tables. They will be focusing on word problems.

In **Science**, students will be beginning a new topic called 'Life Processes'. During this unit they will learn about basic life processes common to animals and plants.

In **IPC**, students will begin their new topic 'Treasure'. In this topic they will begin to learn about and explore the different types of treasure there are.

In **Art / Technology**, students will be continuing or starting to make their photo frames.

In **ICT**, students will be continuing their work on emailing. We will discuss e-safety again and talk about email etiquette or 'netiquette'. Some children are keen to use their emails at home too.

For **PSHE**, students will complete the last section of the 'Healthy Me' puzzle piece. This area of study is called 'My Amazing Body' and the children will discuss some fascinating facts about the human body.
