Welcome to the Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) programme at the Junior Campus, BIS HCMC. The extensive programme on the Junior Campus is designed to extend existing learning opportunities beyond the classroom and to give all children a wider range of fun experiences that enhance the core curriculum. This booklet will help your child to choose their activities for Term 2 of the 2019-2020 academic year.

There is an extensive range of CCAs available to choose from each week at the BIS Junior Campus, and we would like to challenge and encourage students to explore some of the exciting new activities being introduced. For a full list of CCAs offered in Term 2, please see below.

As part of our continued enrichment programme, we have organised clubs into 5 categories to help all children choose a variety of clubs with the aim to vary their experiences.

The categories are: **Art, Community, Language, Sports, and Technology.** Clubs are divided into 2 different types:

Free clubs – offered by teachers covering a wide range of different activities.

Paid clubs – offered by outside providers, these clubs often require specialist tuition.

Please note that during residential trips week, clubs will still take place. Overall fees will have taken this into account and there will not be a refund for sessions missed.

In addition to these offerings, sport squads will be chosen by the PE Dept based upon a strong ability level linked to prior performance. Children may be invited to join some of the initial sessions before final decisions are made. On sign up, always remember to select general club preferences and Squad selections to avoid possible disappointment if a squad criterion is not met. Squad selections always take precedence over general club preferences.

Each child in Y3 to Y6 is entitled to enrol in up to three free clubs and unlimited paid clubs. Please note that we do not guarantee three free clubs as all selections are random.

How do you register for a club?

You may register your child for a club from Monday 9th December at 5.00pm until Friday 13th December at 12.00pm (noon). Clubs have maximum and minimum numbers which change according to the activity. See instructions below for CHQ Sign-up.

For those popular clubs that have set student limits, spaces are chosen randomly by CHQ and those who gain a place are notified. Children who sign up for paid clubs that are oversubscribed will be placed on a waiting list. Clubs may be cancelled if there are not enough children as required.

Paid clubs will be confirmed via email to those who have been allocated a place. The email will come with an attached letter for parents to print and complete. The letter will need to be submitted to the Junior Primary cashier within the payment period (13th – 15th January). Please note, if payment is not made during this time, then the place will be offered to the children who have been placed on a waiting list - this will be strictly enforced. Please note that all paid club payments are non-refundable (unless BIS cancel the programme).

On-line Activity Selection

All activities (free and paid) need to be selected on-line. Please see below for instructions. You will be able to see updates and changes to your approved activities through your on-line CHQ homepage.

Please note that your first, second or third preferences may not always be possible to allocate and due to this process there is no way of guaranteeing siblings will have clubs on the same day or time.



Guidelines for accessing CHQ

Term 2, 2019-2020

Please note that the information below can only be accessed after the system goes live at 5.00pm on Monday 9th December 2019 and before close at 12pm of Friday the 13th December 2019.

This system has been set up for you to use on a daily basis to select and track all your child's chosen activities. It can be found by going to the school website (www.bisvietnam.com) and clicking on the CHQ tab located on the home page, or by clicking here to go directly to CHQ. Once your selected activities have been approved you will be able to see them on 'My Profile'. Please follow the instructions below to log on and select your desired activities.



Instructions will be easy to follow and can be found in the pale yellow section pointed out by the red arrow in the diagram on the next page.

Signing up procedure

Step 1. Click here to access CHO tab

Log on using your child's school internet user name and password.

Child's user name: (E.g. tperson@bisvietnam.net)

Password: (this will have already been emailed to you, but if you cannot find it, simply use the forget password option and reset – see below for instructions on how to do this?

Step 2. You should now see a Home screen with instructions.



- Step 3. From the Home Page under 'My Activities 2019-2020 Term 2 select View/Manage/ Submit Activity Choices'.
- Step 4. Please choose clubs carefully by numbering in preference order 1 to 8 in the CHQ club options, with number 1 being your child's first choice and number 8 being the eighth favourite choice out of all available CCAs. You no longer need to choose free clubs as choice 1 to 3, paid clubs 4 to 6 and so on. Simply order in preference all available clubs 1 to 8. For example, the Swimming by Paul Saddler might be your child's first choice, choir might be the second choice, cricket club third, right through to choice 8.

Example:

My child would like to choose 'Swimming by Paul Saddler' (paid) and then 'Choir' (free), 'Cricket club' (free) and 'Rising Stars Football Academy' (paid).

- Put a number 1 to select 'Swimming by Paul Saddler first preference,
- Put a number 2 to select 'Choir' second preference,
- Put a number 3 to select the 'Cricket Club'- third preference,
- Put a number 4 to select 'Rising Stars Football Academy' fourth preference,
- And all the way to preference 8.

Ensure that you click 'Save' after your selections are made to log each club preference.

*Children will be selected to join the Squad clubs by the PE Department based upon high ability levels and prior performance.

Please note, you need to consider club choices very carefully, as this coming term all clubs will be selected randomly by CHQ, and there will not be an option to change clubs once selections have been made. Changes of clubs are time consuming for the office staff and the decision has been taken to be strict with the no-change procedures. So please save any disappointment by choosing very carefully. Due to all clubs being chosen randomly, there will be those who miss out on CCAs, so we apologise in advance to those who do not get their initial choices. However, the system does record those who missed out on clubs and they will be given preference for that club in Term 3 if it is offered again. CCAs must be signed up on CHQ, as CCA allocation will not be accepted in the office. This also will be strictly enforced.

Before the club programme begins on Monday 10th February, click onto the 'My Schedule' tab and scroll through to Monday 10th February - you will be able to see your accepted clubs. In addition to this, all accepted clubs will be confirmed to you via email before the Term 2 club programme begins.

Please remember that you may choose as many paid clubs as you wish that fit into your child's schedule and all clubs are subject to a minimum and maximum limit - once filled there will be no additions.

Please note - If you forget your login details, please follow the instructions below.
