our **Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs)** are an integral part of the education offered at BIS HCMC and provide our students with a broad range of learning opportunities which impact positively on many facets of their development, including academic progress. This year, more so than any other, we wish to encourage our students to engage with our new Virtual CCAs (VCCAs) in order to provide them with vital opportunities to meet and work with students and teachers outside of the group they would see on a day-to-day basis during our Virtual School Experience. We are very excited to be offering our students an entirely new CCA experience, and we hope to see them take advantage of the great opportunities on offer. Read on...

Term 1B – Monday 1st November to Friday 3rd December 2021 (Block 2 - 5 weeks)

Welcome to the Virtual Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) programme at the EYI Campus, BIS HCMC. The extensive programme on the EYI Campus is designed to extend existing learning opportunities beyond the classroom and to give all children a wider range of fun experiences that enhance the core curriculum. This booklet will help your child to choose their activities for the **second block** of Term 1 CCAs for the 2021-2022 academic year. Following the October holiday, we will begin a second block of VCCAs with an opportunity to join a different club for a new 5-week block.

There is an extensive range of VCCAs available to choose from each week at the BIS EYI Campus, and we would like to challenge and encourage students to explore some of the exciting new activities being introduced. For a full list of Virtual CCAs offered during block 2, please see below.

As part of our continued enrichment programme, we have organised clubs into 5 categories to help all children choose a variety of clubs with the aim to vary their experiences. The categories are:

Art, Community, Language, Sports, and Technology

Clubs are divided into 3 different types:

Free Clubs Live – offered by teachers covering a wide range of different activities on a set day and time.

Free Clubs Pre-Recorded – offered by teachers covering a wide range of different activities recorded and released each Monday. You will be able to do the activity on any day. *Paid clubs* – offered by outside providers, these clubs often require specialist tuition.

One of these VCCAs is a Virtual Swimming Squad Club that will be offered by the PE Department. Keep in mind that this selection will count as your one free club. If you had choir previously then this will be an automatic section for block.

Each child in F2 to Y2 is offered <u>one Free Club or Pre-Recorded Club and unlimited Paid Clubs</u>. Please note that <u>we do not guarantee that the free club will be approved</u> as all selections are generated randomly by the computer.

Kegistering your child:

How do you register your child for a club?

As a school, BIS HCMC have moved away from the previous host, CHQ, to a brand new, user friendly provider, SchoolsBuddy. This move between platforms will provide you as parents a much smoother experience. Details on how to access SchoolsBuddy will be provided later in this booklet.

You may register your child for a club from <u>Wednesday 6th October at 8.00am until Monday 11th</u> <u>October at 12.00pm (noon).</u> Clubs have maximum and minimum numbers which change according to the activity. See instructions on the following pages for Schools Buddy Sign-up.



For those popular clubs that have set student limits, spaces are chosen randomly by SchoolsBuddy and those who gain a place are notified. Children who sign up for paid clubs that are oversubscribed will be placed on a waiting list. Clubs may be cancelled if there are not enough children as required.

Paid clubs will be confirmed via email to those who have been allocated a place. **Payment period** will be from Wednesday 13th October to Wednesday 20th October and <u>must be completed through</u> online banking as there will be no access to the campus during this time. If unable to make online transfers into the school provided account, please do not consider a paid VCCA. Please note, if payment is not made during this time, then the place will be offered to the children who have been placed on a waiting list - this will be strictly enforced. Please note that all paid club payments are non-refundable (unless BIS cancel the programme), and that if a paid VCCA fails to reach minimum numbers, the club will not run.

On-line Activity Selection

All activities (free and paid) need to be selected on-line. Please see following pages for instructions and you will be able to see updates and changes to your approved activities through your on-line SchoolsBuddy homepage.

<u>Choosing carefully is vital as the system will not be able to make changes once VCCAs have been</u> <u>allocated.</u>



VCCAs Payment Procedure

Due to the current situation in Ho Chi Minh City, payments for those paid VCCA options that your child has been accepted into can only be made through online banking. If unable to fulfil these conditions, again, please do not sign your child up for a paid VCCA as an option.

Payment amounts for those clubs that your child has been accepted into will be emailed to you on **Wednesday October 13th**; with payment available from 8am that morning and will close on **Wednesday October 20th** at the end of the banking day. All VCCAs will begin on the week beginning the 1st of November. If payment has not been cleared by our accounts team by **Wednesday the 20th October**, a place will not be available.
