# Learning Theme Ten Days of Chinese New Year!

The children have really enjoyed learning and joining in with our Three Billy Goats Gruff story and we are now ready to learn about another story involving animals. We will begin our new theme of Chinese New Year next week, and will be doing a variety of exciting New Year activities including introducing the story of the Chinese Zodiac. We will also be creating all kinds of goat inspired art work, writing wishing tree wishes, dancing to traditional Chinese music, role playing in our Chinese restaurant and cooking Chinese rice balls, yum yum!



### Expressive Arts & Design:

2015 is the year of the Goat, so we will find out lots of facts about goats and encourage the children to use their imagination to create their own goats, they can draw, paint, construct or make a goat collage. We will begin creating dragon heads too, which we will then use as a prop when we dance to Chinese music.
