1. Join

Want to take part? Join the competition online.

- Go to the Primary section on Global Campus Online and click on the Visual Arts competition box.
- Join the competition to unlock the rest of the page. Click the yellow button to join and earn a certificate.
- Speak to a teacher if you don't know how to log into Global Campus Online.

- Hand it to your teacher – they will send entries to the Global Campus team



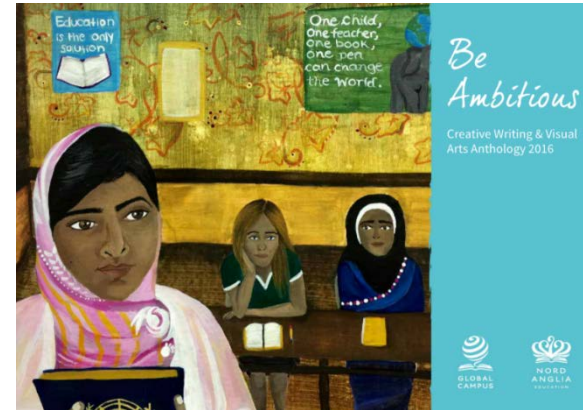
Rules

- The judge's decision is final

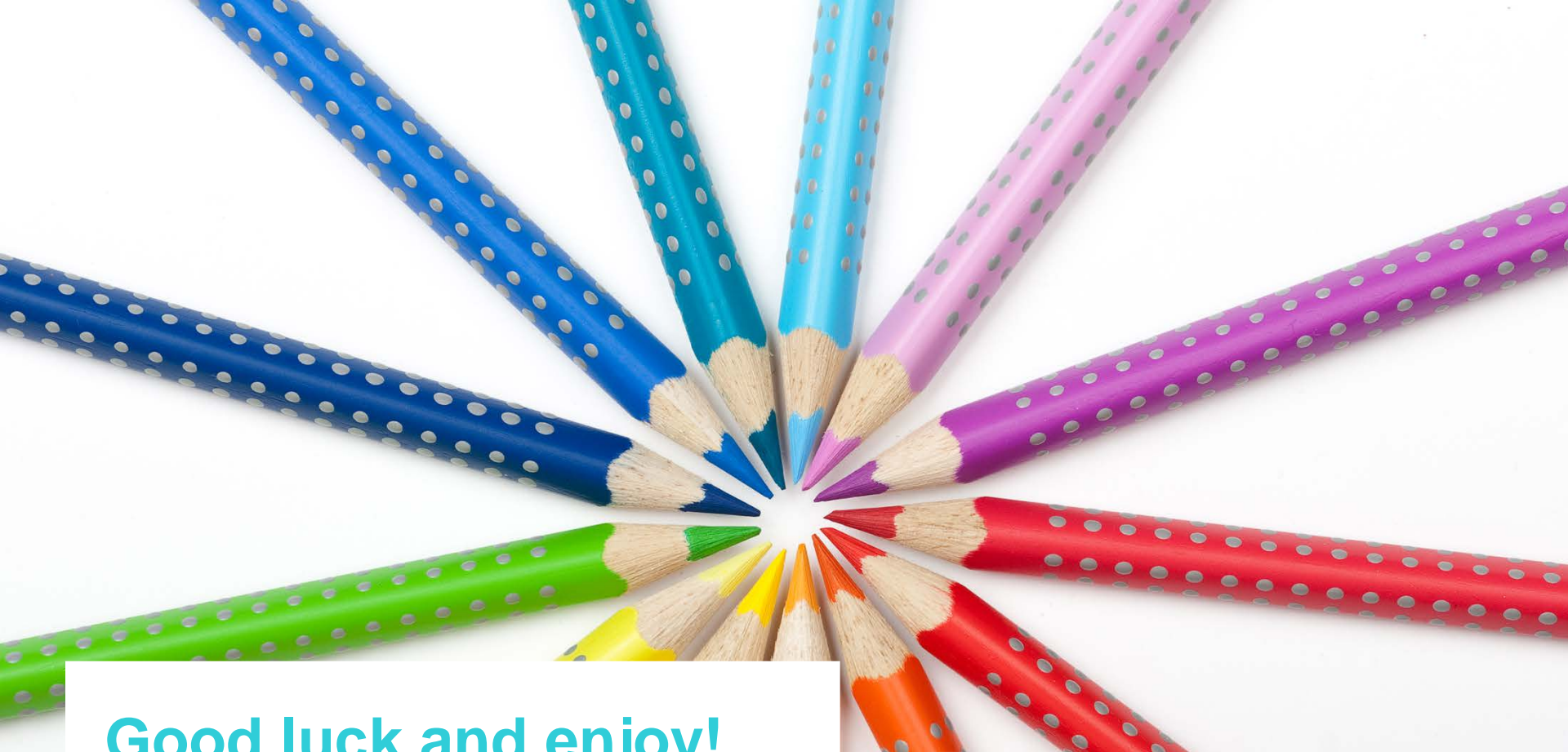


Prizes
