Literacy

This week in literacy the children are concluding our fairytale topic working on the classic story *Beauty and the Beast,* developing their sequencing, re-telling and writing skills through activities linked to this story.

Phonics

This week in phonics all groups are revising term two phonic sounds and spellings, now applying this new phonic knowledge to writing across other subject areas.

Maths

In Math, students will continue their work with 3D shapes, applying their understanding of these shapes across the curriculum. Students will be exploring Art through the use of 3D shapes.
