Stressful events may have dramatic impact on children so developing a resilient mind-set is an important coping strategy. To build resilience, children need to know they can make a difference (i.e. they have control), they feel worthwhile and valued (i.e. have self-esteem) and have people in their life who love and support them (unconditionally). As parents we should always strive to make our children feel valued and appreciated (e.g. we need to ask their opinion, look for the positives), don't judge or compare them to siblings or others, avoid telling them what to do, instead give them choices when problems arise, give approval and encouragement for trying new things and do little special rituals or routines every day to build a sense of security. (e.g. a smile and/or hug or a favourite snack when greeting your child after they get home from school)
