Starters: Numeracy



Create flashcards with your times tables on that you can use at home to help you practise.



Write inverse division number sentences for your times tables.



Write word problems that involve your times tables.



Create a colour-by-numbers picture based on your times tables.

Main Course – you **MUST** do these every week:

- Reading 3 times a week
- 10 spellings
- Times Tables
- Mathematics
- Reading Eggs

- Everyone **must** finish the main course every week. Work must be completed by Tuesday.
