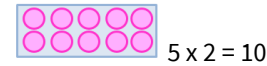

I can draw and solve the 2, 5, 10 times tables with arrays



I can read O'clock, half past and quarter past on a clock.
I can read quarter to and tell the time in 5-minute increments.

I can subtract 2-digit numbers. E.g. 57-23.

I can add 2-digit numbers. E.g. 28 + 34.

I can use positional movement words like; quarter turn, half turn, 3 quarter turn.

I can solve adding or subtracting word problems.

I can solve multiplying or dividing word problems.
