

German & Spanish Curriculum Overview

Modern Foreign Languages Key Stage 3- Year 6

Introduction Phase

Students learn and practice basic communication within the classroom, such as asking for help, working together, being polite with each other or just common language they will need during games or activities. They will also discuss how to make progress during the coming terms and set their own targets.

<u>All about me</u>

Students learn to use greetings and talk about themselves. They will be able to introduce themselves by name, age, where they live and where they come from. Students will also be able to say what they like and dislike and talk about what they have or haven't got. They will be able to make some references to family, friends, pets and hobbies, which will be learned in more depth during later topics.

My family and friends

Students will learn to introduce their family members, friends and pets. They will be able to describe other people's character and what they look like. Students will be able to talk about what other people like or dislike and what they do.

Students will get to know what typical families in other countries look like and what it means to be a good friend. They will learn how pets are accepted in different cultures and they will be able to give short reasons to support their opinions.

<u>My school</u>

Students will learn to talk about the school subjects and state their opinion about them. They will be able to describe their timetable and a typical day at school. Students will learn to tell the time and the days of the week. Moreover, they will learn to say what places there are around school and what a good school looks like in their opinion. They will learn to describe their school uniform and say what snack do they eat during breaktime.

From a cultural side, students will look at target country school systems, school uniforms and what a typical school day looks like in other countries.
