Literacy

In Literacy this week, students will continue to explore VCOP (Vocabulary, Connectives, Openers, Punctuation) and how it can be used to edit and improve their written work. When Barnaby Bear visits the UK, students will learn how to write a postcard from Barnaby Bear to his family, recounting some of the things he has done on his trip. Students will be encouraged to apply the techniques they have used during our of work on recounts such as the use of time connective openers, interesting adjectives as well as accurate capital letters and full stops.

Phonics

Each group will be covering the following sounds this week:

Stingray- e, u, r (phase two sounds) students will also revise s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, o, g, c, k, ck Jellyfish- short oo (book/look) and long oo (zoo/food)

Octopus- consonant digraphs e.g. ch, sh, th, ng

Shark- phase four high frequency words (tricky words)

Puffer Fish- alternative spelling of 'ee' sound (as e_e and ie)

Maths

In Maths, we will be learning more about numbers and the properties of number. Children will continue to explore numbers up to and beyond 20, learn their number bonds to 10, read and write numbers accurately, as well as find patterns in number sequences. By the end of the week, children will be able to count forwards and backwards with increased confidence, have a wider understanding of the place value of digits in a 1-digit and a 2-digit number and an enhanced knowledge of their number bonds to 10.

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Themed Learning - Who Am I?

This week, Barnaby Bear will visit the UK. Students will learn where the UK is on a world map as well as some interesting things to do and places to visit. Students will experience the British tradition of drinking tea and eating biscuits. In Art, they will finish their aboriginal pieces and their Japanese lanterns.

Computer Science

This week in Computing Science, students will begin to explore how to use the computer to generate graphs and pictograms. Using an online programme (TES iboard), students will ask and answer survey questions and then organise their results into graphs and pictograms. Linking with our themed Learning topic, students will ask questions such as 'What is your favourite snack?' Following this, children will be able to draw on their understanding of healthy eating and a balanced diet.

PSHCE- Conflict/Resolution

Over the next few weeks, students will work with their class teachers learning about conflict, the reason why conflict occurs and how to resolve it. In Circle Time, students will be given the opportunity to discuss any current difficulties they are experiencing on the playground and in school. Children will be encouraged to consider the factors which lead to conflict arising and how to achieve a successful resolution.
