Starters: Reading



Visit the National Library and take out a book on Ancient Romans.



Identify all the features of a non-fiction text, write them down and explain their purpose.



Create a glossary of topic-related words that you do not know the meaning of.



Create your own text, complete with all the non-fiction features, based on the Ancient Greeks and Romans.

Main Course – you **MUST** do these every week:

- Reading 3 times a week
- 10 spellings
- Times Tables
- Mathematics
- Reading Eggs

- Everyone **must** finish the main course every week. Work must be completed by Tuesday.
- Dessert projects are optional. If you have completed it, you will be asked to present your work to your teachers and peers.
