

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, we will be focusing on poetry and performance poems in particular. We will be retelling stories in an interesting manner to an audience, before recapping our learning over the term.

In **Numeracy**, we will be learning to use short multiplication to multiply 4-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers and will use this to multiply amounts of money; solve word problems involving multiplication including two-step problems and finding change. We will also use long multiplication to multiply 3-digit and 4-digit numbers by teen numbers.

In **Science**, we will be assessing the children on what they have learned over the duration of our current Science topic 'Food Chains'. This will include questions about key terminology such as: producer, consumer, prey, predator, adaptation. We will also be introducing our new topic of 'Force and Energy' in preparation for next term.

Our **IPC** will be looking at the advantages and disadvantages of living in Qatar and discussing what factors are important for us to have a good quality of life. We will also be trying to develop solutions to global problems such as air pollution and overcrowding.

In **ICT**, we will be starting to look at using Scratch as a program and how to create a game.

In **PSHE**, we will be creating a game to play as a group in the playground.

For **Spellings**, students will receive their spelling lists on Thursday and will be tested on the list the following week. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
