Our subjects in the Spotlight this week are...ICT and computing.

Year 7: This term, Year 7 students have been doing an 'introduction to Python' course where they have learnt about coding fundamentals using the syntax of the Python programming language. During the last few weeks of term, pupils will begin to write short programs using the skills they have learnt in previous lessons.

Year 8: This term, Year 8 students have been doing a 'Python Numbers' course where they have learnt about how mathematical operators, strings (text) and integers (numbers) are interpreted using the syntax of the Python programming language. During the last few weeks of term, pupils will begin to write short programs using the skills they have learnt in previous lessons.

Year 9: This term, Year 9 students have been doing an 'introduction to HTML and website' course where they have learnt about coding HTML codes and working with templates, tables and hyperlinks. The students will create a website based on a topic of interest and add suitable content.

Year 10: This term the Year 10 students have been learning about mail-merging, HTML and websites, alongside revising numerous past exam papers and theory related to encryption, networks and storage devices.

Year 11: Year 11 are awaiting the results of their ICT exams back in May.
