

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **<u>next</u> <u>week</u>**.

In *Literacy*, we will be embarking on a new Big Writing adventure, trying to solve the mystery at the Red Café. We will be learning the features of a newspaper article, linking ideas together with adverbials, focusing on the structure of a text and matching form and organising to purpose.

In *Numeracy*, we will be trialing a new revision method strategy by using choice rooms. Each year 5 classroom will be revising a topic for two days. Each child can choose which topic they need extra practice with. This week the topics are: measuring, angles, multiplication, division, fractions and multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000.

In *Science*, we will investigating that when a liquid evaporates from a solution a solid is left behind. We will be predicting first and will then explain what is happening throughout the experiment.

Our **IPC**, we will be researching about different Myths and Legends focussing on our goal, finding out about aspects of the past from a range of sources. For the remainder of the week, with the research collected, children will be creating together a presentation about their Myth and presenting it to the class on Thursday.

In ICT, students will be using the app Sketch Up to continue creating their art galleries. They will learn how to add stairs in by watching a video and then recreating on theirs. They will also start to evaluate each other's and see how they can improve their gallery.

In **PSHE**, we will be focusing on Global Warming. We will be looking at how we can help the environment by investigating how plastic affects it and what we can do to reduce the amount of plastic we throw away.

For *Spellings*, students will receive their spelling lists every week and will be tested on the list on the same day, the following week. Please see student's timetables to see when they have spellings. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
