A Look at Learning

Class Mascots in Foundation 2

In our Foundation 2 classes, we have mascots to represent our class names. Ms Melissa explains more:

In the Foundation 2 Lions class, our class mascot is ‘Larry The Lion,’ who is adored by all students. Every other week, a student is chosen to take Larry home for a full week. In between times, the class mascot gets a thorough wash and the mascot’s special book is carefully wiped clean ready for the next stage of his journey.

The children are asked to document their time and experiences shared with Larry by adding photos, by drawing pictures or by writing in Larry’s journey book. At the end of Larry’s visit to their home, the student is then asked to participate in a ‘show and tell’ session with the class to explain what they have added to Larry’s special book.

Having our class mascot in the children’s homes gives them the opportunity to become more responsible individuals by taking care of something

that belongs to our whole class. It also helps them to develop their communication skills by explaining to the class their favourite experiences with our beloved Larry.
