Visitors, Emergency Procedures, Security and Fire Safety

Where the incident has taken place

Fire Alarm details.

Fire Alarm is audible in all areas. Siren and verbal instructions in Arabic and English. Strobe in corridors.

OR

Any warning will be given verbally, please follow the instructions on the Fire Action Notices which are situated in all rooms.

If you hear the Alarms you will need to evacuate the building immediately and in silence.

When outside make your way to the assembly point at:

Assembly point 1 - KS2 Play Area at rear of school / Assembly point 2 – Sports pitch Astroturf / Assembly Point 3 Front of Building on Pavement, and wait in designated area for all clear.

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Fire extinguishers are located at all entrance and exit points to the building.

Emergency fire evacuation alarm will be tested on:

Do not obstruct entrance and exit doors or fire extinguishers.

In the event of a bomb threat, a verbal warning will be given and evacuation will proceed as for a fire evacuation.

The system is linked with the Civil Defence and will be contacted automatically unless organised test.

If the activation is false or a test the alarm will be silenced by the Incident Manager once the building sweep has been complete. Time to fresh air should be 3 mins NAE Standard.
