Starters: Reading

With your reading book, pick out any adjectives you can find that describe a picture. Using those words, draw a picture of what you think they would look like.

Create a timeline of events that happen in your book.

Find a book you have never read before and look at the front cover. Predict what you think the story will be about and who the main character is.

Discuss the purpose of the book. Why did the author choose to write this book? Who is the audience?
