Starters: Revision

Please support your child in completing any areas of the Year 2 Revision Pack that was sent home this week.

Please note any areas that you would like your child to have further practise in, in their communication book.

Main Course – you **MUST** do these every week:

- Read for 15 minutes - 5 times per week
 - Learning weekly spellings
 - Times table practise
 - 15 minutes on Mathletics/Reading Eggs – 3 times per week
 - 1 x Numeracy – Worksheet
 - 1 x Literacy Activity Sheet
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- Everyone **must** finish the main course every week. Work must be completed in your Home Learning books and returned to school on Wednesday of each week.
 - Everyone **must** attempt one, or both, of the project deserts. You will be asked to present your work to your teachers and peers.
 - If you are feeling *extra* hungry, you can order from the starters. These will focus on a different subject each week. Each dish has a difficulty rating. The more chillies, the more *challenging* the task!

In **Literacy**, we will be writing our own pirate poems and performing them to the class.

Mr Spencer's group: 'ear' as in fear, and 'air' as in hair.

Mrs Burgess' group: 'ay' as in play, and 'ou' as in cloud.

Ms Dianne's group: revision of all sounds learned this term.

Ms Claire's group: split diagraphs – 'a_e', 'u_e'.

Ms Dipti, Ms Clara and Ms Asma's groups: 10 Year 2 Tricky/High Frequency Words, as found in their communication book.
